

LUNATI VOODOO: THREE NEW CAMSHAFTS FOR HARLEYS



Lunati has announced **three** new series of Voodoo hydraulic roller **camshafts** for Harley Davidson Evolution big twins, for Twin Cams from 1999-2006, and for Twin Cams from 2007 to current.

Features:

- These new cams offer three distinct characteristics: low-end torque with strong mid-range power for touring; peak horsepower; or a combination of both.
- The Evolution series is also available as an easy-to-install kit, containing valve springs, spring seats, steel retainers, and valve stem locks.
- The performance advantage of the Voodoo cam lies in its asymmetrically ground lobes—one side of the ramp is usually straight to the nose of the lobe while the opposite (closing) ramp profile has a pronounced dip or wave in the middle. The benefit is faster valve opening and slower closing.
- These asymmetrical lobes are also quieter in operation and gentler on the valve train.
- The Voodoo cams improve throttle response, acceleration, and maintain excellent engine vacuum during street use.
- The Parts Listing (link below) presents all of the new Lunati part numbers, the technical data, the RPM ranges, and a handy guide to identify the best cam for the Harley rider.
- All of these cams provide a distinctive new Lunati sound.

It's gratifying when a distinguished old name returns to good health. Lunati, probably employing 70 in number in its heyday, was sold in the megalomaniac era of the late nineties, and in less than a decade found itself on its beam ends with fewer than 20.



In a complete reversal of its original business practices, and much to the consternation of its customers (the racers), it was sinking toward obscurity. Then in November of 2007 new owners resurrected it. They promptly invested it with new management and a new direction, and it's been a dynamo of energy since. And its secret: it's returned to its roots—the racers' company.
